This month we are learning from various parables in the Bible. Read through this week's parable found in Matthew 25:1-13 about the 10 Maidens. This parable focuses on what it means to be preparing for Jesus' return. He told us that one day He would return and we should be living our lives in light of that truth. Use the questions provided to get a conversation started about this week's lesson.

- 1. What was the best part of your day?
- 2. What was the hardest part of your day?
- 3. What is one thing you are thankful for today?
- 4. Who were the 10 maidens waiting for? (the groom) What did each of them bring with them as they waited? (their lamps so they could see)
- 5. Who does the groom represent in the story? (Jesus)
- 6. Who do the bridesmaids/maidens represent? (the church/us)
- 7. We know that Jesus will return, but do we know WHEN He will return? (No, the Bible tells us that we do not know the time or place of His return)
- 8. What can you do now to be ready for when Jesus does come back? (Give, pray, tell others about Jesus, etc.)
- 9. How can you know that "you've been invited to the wedding festivities" and have a hope and a future of eternity with Jesus? (By asking Jesus Christ for forgiveness and for HIm to be your Lord and Savior)
